


## FOR PLACEMENT ON A MONITOR

## FOR PLACEMENT ON A TRIPOD\*


1. Locate the M12 tripod thread on the bottom of the webcam.





#### CONNECTING THE WEBCAM


Plug the webcam into an available USB port on your computer




**2.** Adjust the webcam to make sure the foot on the universal mounting clip is flush with the back of your device.




2. Secure the webcam on your tripod by twisting it into the M12 thread.



**3.** Manually adjust the webcam up/down to the best position to frame yourself.




Place your webcam with the tripod anywhere you desire to the best position to frame yourself.


